

DATA PROTECTION DECLARATION

in accordance with the Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP)

The company Cattaneo Impianti SA, with registered office in Morbio Inferiore, Via Ghitello 4 (hereinafter, the "**Company**"), in its capacity as data controller, intends to inform you about the methods of processing the personal data of users who consult and use the services accessible electronically through the Company's website.

Therefore, the Company, guaranteeing compliance with the requirements of national and European regulations on the protection of personal data, declares the following:

1) Type of data collected and processed

The personal data processed by the Company are of two types:

- common identification data (such as, for example: email address, personal data) and information contained in the body of the message provided directly and voluntarily by the user at the time of sending messages or communications via e-mail to the Data Controller through the "Contacts" section of the website;
- browsing data collected independently (for example: IP address, browser type, computer information, domain names of the computers used by users who connect to the site, URI addresses of the resources requested, the time of the request and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's IT environment).

These data are used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its correct functioning. This data is deleted immediately after processing. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in the event of hypothetical computer crimes against the site.

As regards the use of "Cookies", please refer to the specific and detailed information.

2) Purpose of the processing

The personal data provided by users are processed to respond to questions and/or communications sent voluntarily by e-mail by the same and to process any requests contained in the message forwarded to the Company.

3) Processing methods

Users' personal data are processed both manually (e.g., on paper) and electronically, electronically and electronically, in the manner strictly necessary to meet the purposes referred to in Article 2 of this declaration, in compliance with the applicable legal provisions and according to the principles of lawfulness, good faith and proportionality.

4) Data access

Access to the data is allowed only to employees of the Company authorized to process under the direct authority of the data controller or processor, to whom specific written instructions have been provided, in compliance with the provisions on the protection of personal data. The processing is carried out with the use of security measures suitable to prevent unauthorized access to data by third parties and to guarantee their confidentiality.

5) Communication and transmission of data

The data collected are not subject to dissemination or to any fully automated decision-making process, including profiling.

Where necessary, the Company will communicate users' personal data to third parties, as "data processors", such as service providers (e.g., IT system assistance and maintenance companies), engaged in the correct and regular pursuit of the purposes described.

In any case, the processing by third parties must take place within the limits necessary for the performance of their task, in compliance with the provisions of the law on the protection of personal data. The updated list of data processors is kept at the headquarters of the data controller.

6) Rights of data subjects and how to exercise them

Persons affected by the processing have the right to request information in accordance with Article 25 of the FADP.

Since the data processing is based on the consent of the data subject, the data subject has the right to revoke his or her consent at any time with effect for the future.

In addition, you can invoke all other rights under the FADP, such as the right to obtain confirmation that personal data concerning the data subject is being processed and to obtain access to personal data concerning him or her, as a rule this information must be provided to the data subject within 30 days of his or her request.

The communication of data is optional. However, failure to provide it will make it impossible for the data controller to provide the information and answers requested by the user via e-mail.

To exercise these rights, the data subject may contact the data controller referred to in Article 1) of this declaration. Your request will be processed in accordance with the law. The response to such a request may be denied or limited in accordance with legal provisions. In such a case, the data controller will provide a copy of the personal data being processed.

If the data subject submits the request by electronic means, and unless otherwise indicated, the information will be provided in a commonly used electronic format.

In addition, the data subject has the option under the FADP to contact the Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner (<u>www.edoeb.admin.ch</u>).

7) Processing of personal data and General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Where necessary, the Company will be entitled to transfer data outside of Switzerland. The transmission will take place only for the purposes indicated in the Declaration and in the manner and within the limits provided for by the FADP. Therefore, where the criteria of territorial applicability require it, the Company guarantees compliance with the legislation provided for in the GDPR.

Outside the territorial scope of the GDPR, the Company may, if necessary, transfer the Client's personal data in compliance with the applicable legal provisions and subject to verification of the adequate protection of the recipient countries, in accordance with Annex 1 to the Data Protection Ordinance of the Swiss Federal Council.

8) Personal data retention period

The data controller retains the data for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes indicated in Article 2 of this declaration. Such data will be deleted when they are no longer necessary for the purposes indicated above, without prejudice to further retention obligations provided for by applicable legislation.

9) Changes to the Declaration

An amendment to this statement may be necessary in the event of a change in data protection legislation or a change in the way personal data is processed by the Company. In
